Autism Diagnostic Evaluation

HopeCentral is a general pediatric clinic with an Autism Center of Excellence designation. We offer multidisciplinary diagnostic evaluations for children that follow best practice guidelines established by the *American Psychological Association* and the *American Academy of Pediatrics*. We accept referrals for evaluations from primary care physicians.

Parent Education

HopeCentral offers First Steps, a 3-class series for parents of children who were recently diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). First Steps will familiarize you with community resources for your child, and teach strategies that you can use at home to promote development. This series is open to the general public and costs \$45. Scholarships are available for those who qualify.

Primary Care

We believe that a familiar, consistent, and trusted source of healthcare is important for all children, especially for those with ASD. Our primary care patients benefit from:

Enhanced physician access — Our patients enjoy unhurried appointments, fast scheduling, and after-hour advice calls answered directly by the doctors.

Integrated behavioral health care — Our on-site behavioral health providers are well-versed in research-based behavioral interventions for problems commonly associated with ASD (e.g., sleep problems, tantrums, self-harm, etc.).

Care Coordination — Our team knows the local resources for children with ASD. We can help you to connect with services and navigate the individual education plan (IEP) process at school.

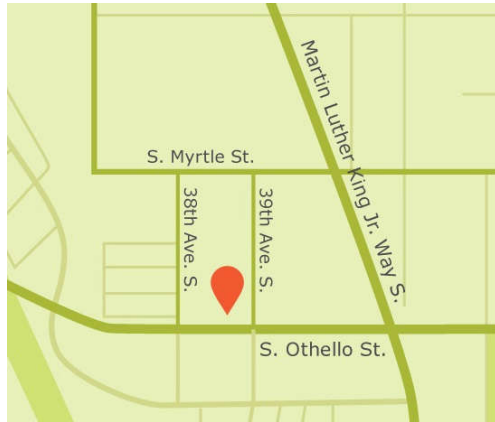
Patricia Scott, M.D., FAAP
